Year 3

English:

This term the children will be writing for a variety of purposes. They will be writing a poem about colour and a story based upon the book 'Wolves in the Walls'.

The children will also be writing a non-chronological report using the book 'Rocks and Soils Beneath our Feet' which links to our science topic on Rocks and Soils.

In Year 3 children need to be able to use: adverbs to denote time, place and manner: use present and past tense correctly; use a / an correctly and use punctuation accurately throughout a piece of writing.

During whole class reading we will be sharing the book 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons'.

Maths:

This term we will be continuing our work on fractions. This will include consolidating our knowledge of equivalent fractions and ordering and comparing fractions. We will then be learning how to add and subtract fractions as well as finding fractions of amounts.

We will also be learning about money, shape, statistics and time including solving problems within each topic. Year 3 will continue to practise times tables in readiness for the Year 4 times table check. Each week the children will be practising the check online.
